- ✓ Inclusion of civil society in the process of restoration and preservation of architectural and cultural heritage.


















2. Practical experience, achievements and results of USERLA in the context of "Host communities and responsible tourism" good practice.

2.1 Burgas Municipality

"St. Anastasia Island" - a small island located 6.5 km southeast from the coast of Burgas.

The place has a statute of historical and cultural sight of national significance. All the buildings on the island

<u>"St. Anastasia"</u> - the newest and the only one in its kind tourist destination in Bulgaria.

The island offers the visitors a wide variety of cultural sights:









Attractions

- ✓ Museum exposition
- ✓ **Cloister** dating back to 15 th. Century
- ✓ **Monastery healer's room**, called "Lekarna"
- ✓ **Monastery kitchen** local restaurant called "One-hundred years back"
- ✓ **Guesthouse** resembles an authentic monks' rooms
- ✓ **Lighthouse** still guiding ships since 1889

"The magic of antiquity and the beauty of nature from the Burgas Bay to Strandja mountain" The project is financed by the Operational Programme "Regional development" 2007-2013

Project outputs

- ✓ A couple of tourist products
- ✓ Ten tourist packages

The *tourist packages* encompass inspiring meetings with **ancient history** and the **beautiful nature** that spread between the Burgas Bay and the Strandja mountain. The main focus is put on the resources and attractions of local villages and their people.

The *tours* in the countryside combine **museum visits**, **heritage sightseeing**, introducing to **local customs**, **work of crafts**, still well kept until nowadays. Local communities are actively engaged and play a leading role in all these activities.

























2.2 Stara Zagora Municipality

"Converting the cultural and historical monuments from ancient times into tourist attraction" The project is funded by the Operational Programme "Regional development" 2007-2013

Main goal

✓ **Develop** and **present** the cultural and heritage landmarks – the excavated part of the ancient Roman town of "Augusta Trayana", located in the centre of the city of Stara Zagora

Attractions

- ✓ Forum complex
- ✓ Ancient street decumanus maximus and its cross-street network
- **✓** Late ancient mosaic
- ✓ Roman dwelling with a pool
- **✓ Portico and mosaic remnants**





























2.3 Sliven Municipality

"Travelling through time, into the time and with the time –an integrated project for development of natural and heritage attractions and tourist infrastructure in the town of Sliven"

Main goal

✓ Renovation, improvement and further development of the existing tourist attractions and especially the Tuida fortress – a historical sight of national interest dating back to the Roman empire, around the middle of 4 th. century

Activities implemented within the project

- ✓ Construction processes for conservation, enrichment and development
- **✓** Education courses for staff training
- **✓** Marketing and promotion activities
