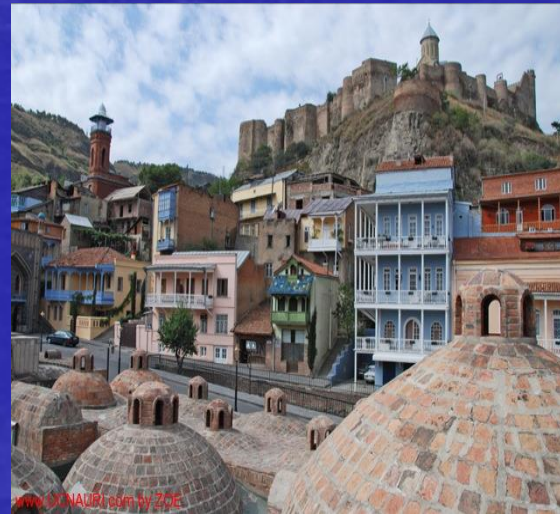
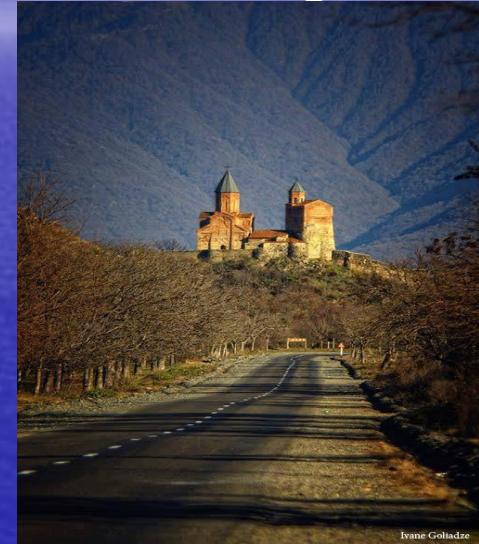
Cultural Heritage as the World Possession

5 thousand out of which are protected by the state



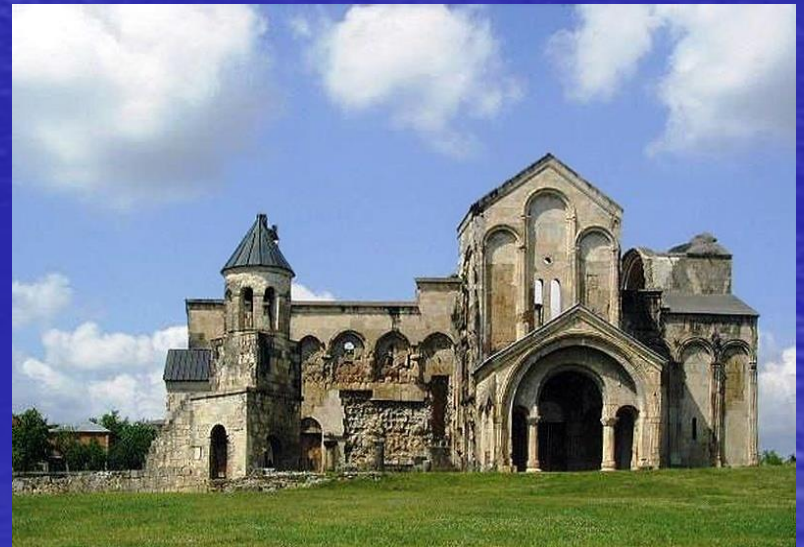

UNESCO World Heritage List includes 878 monuments on the world scale, 0.34% comes on Georgian ones



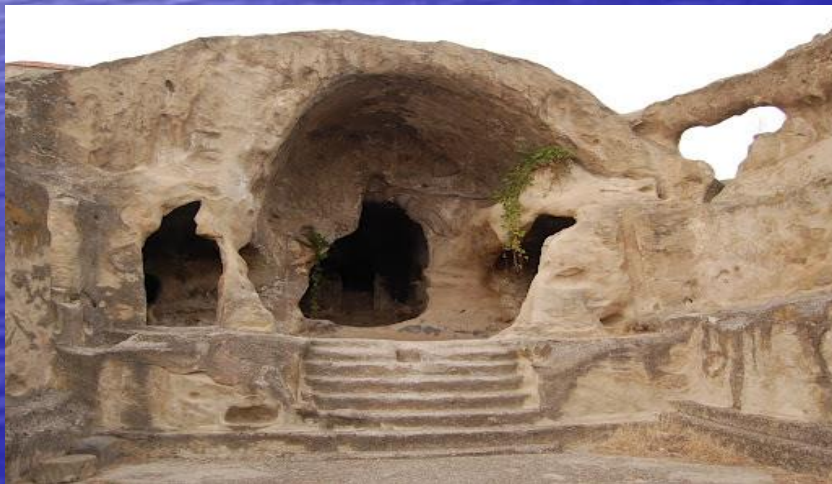
Georgia joined the Convention of the Safeguarding of Intangible Heritage in 2007
